The objective of this project is to help school dropouts, rural tribal boys and girls and widows to enhance their skills to earn their livelihood. Various programmes are running under this programme. ➤ (4).Computer Literacy Program: HUM has been imparting computer literacy program through "COMPUGYAN" Computer Education and Sevan Kendra in association with NIIT Foundation since inception to the poor educated youths of the district and established its centre in its office premise. ➤ (5).Alcoholism and substance (drugs) abuse: HUM has been working and creating awareness camps and conducted rallies in the district to prevent alcoholism and substance abuse and to prevent trafficking of it in the district with the help of district authorities of Assam. <p>The organization is awarded by the Nehru Yuva Kendra (NYK) and Nagaon District Administration as "District Level Youth Club Award" for the outstanding work done for the Youth and the Community.</p>
